2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a **new creation** (including our minds). The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. (ESV)

2 Corinthians 10:5

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we **take captive every thought** to make it obedient to Christ.

Galatians 5:1

It is for freedom that Christ has set us **free**. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery (in our thoughts and minds).

Ephesians 2:1-3

And you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience— among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the **mind**, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind. Ephesians 6:12-13
